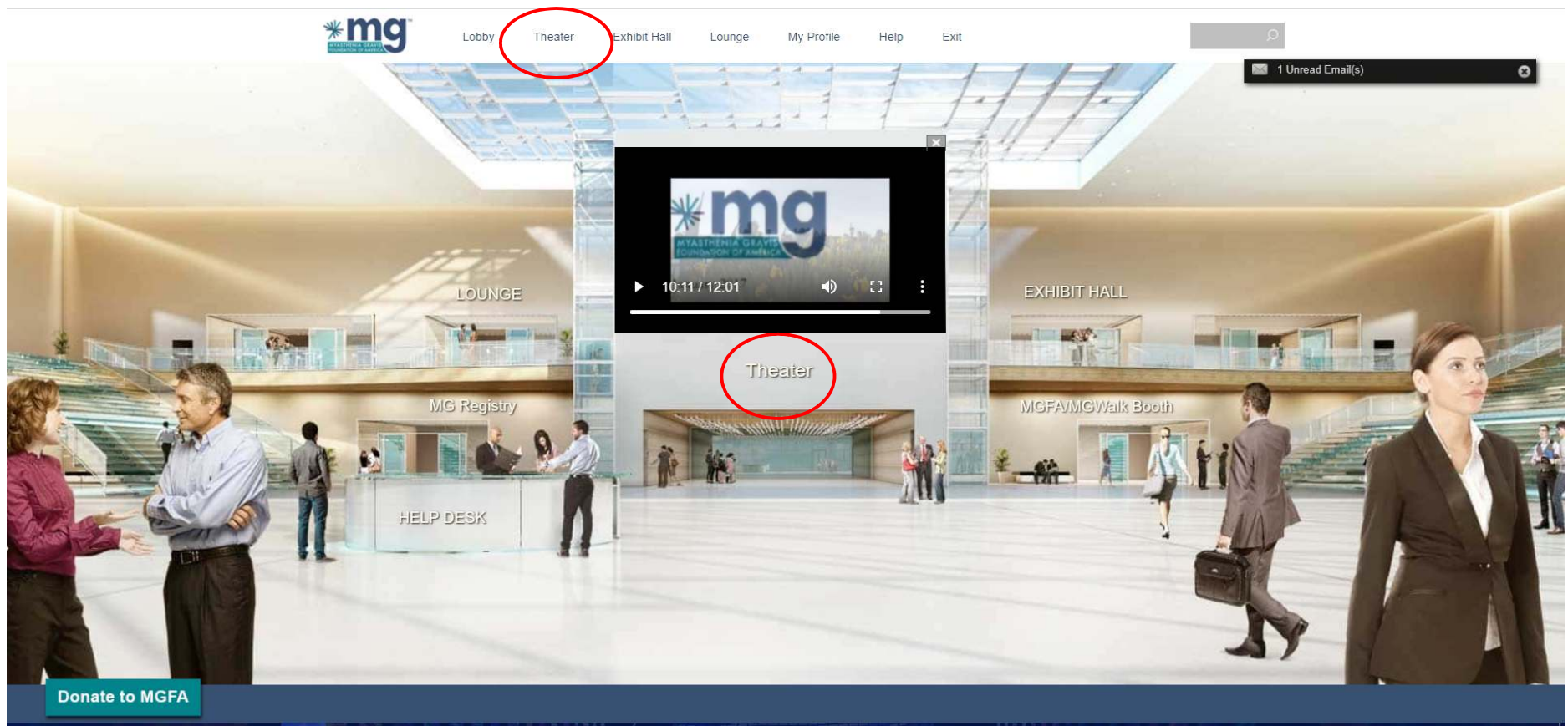


Step 2: Enter Theater to View the List of Presentations

- To download the PDF version of the powerpoint presentation, click on the View button in the bottom right box.

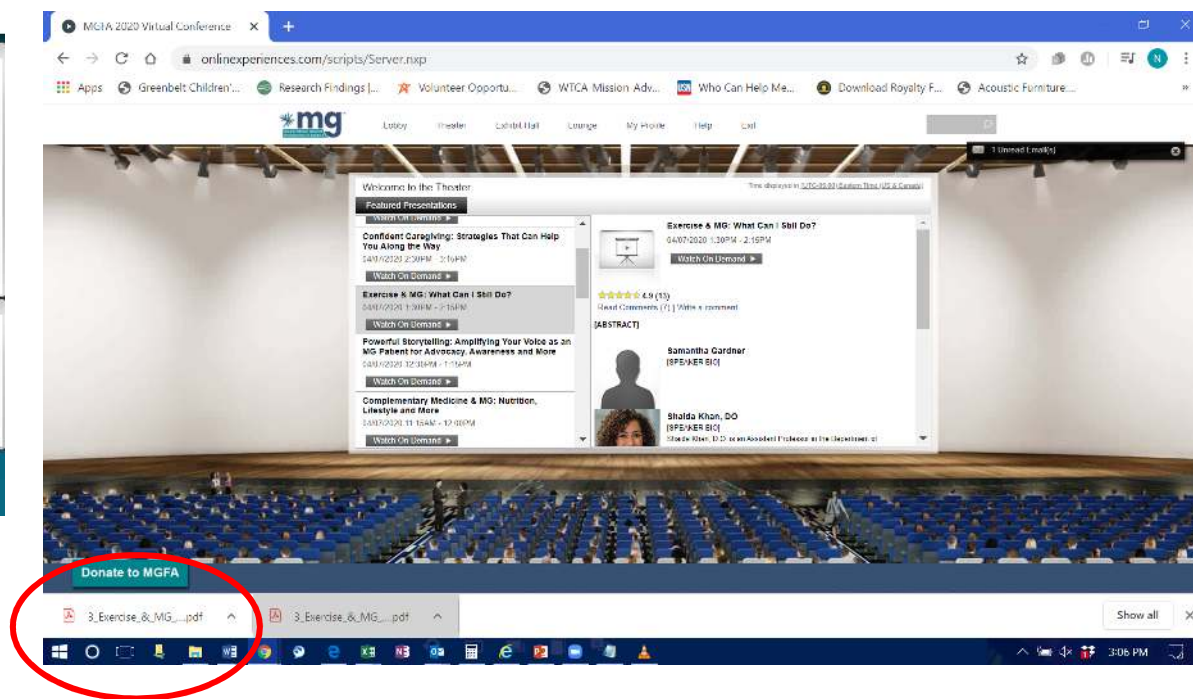
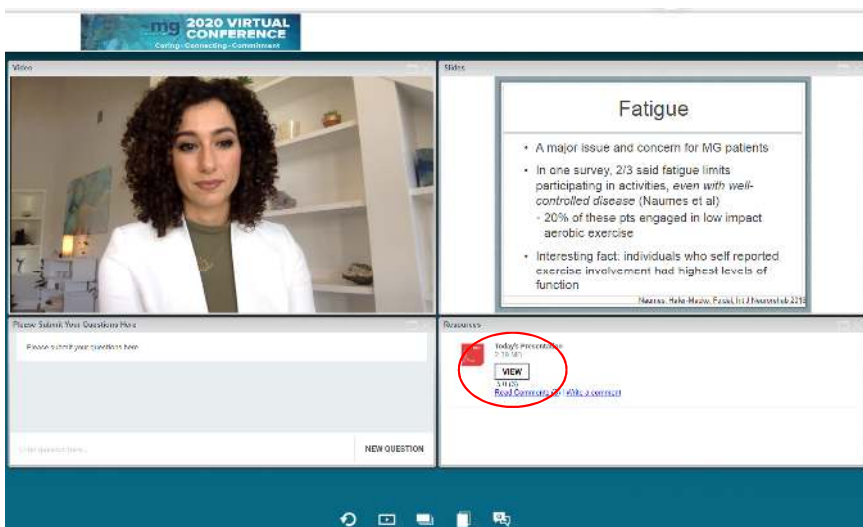
